#### Summary

1. “They have done more cases this year than the Grade A tertiary hospitals.”

The family member of a patient said that they did not feel confident about Wang’s small hospital. Wang said that there was no problem. All the surgeons were actually the doctors and directors from Grade A tertiary hospitals. In his small hospital, “they have done more cases this year than the Grade A tertiary hospitals.”

He also said that he performed surgeries “every day”. “I finished another surgery yesterday, you know.” He said that sometime the caller could not find him by phone, because he was busy with surgeries most of the time.

2. The kidney donors are all “under 25 years old”.

The kidney sources are from young people, “who are all under 25 years old”. “Basically, all of them are under the age of 25, and donors of 27 or 28 years old may be accepted if their conditions are particularly good.” Wang said repeatedly that he guaranteed the donors to be young and healthy.

3. To have a kidney transplant in a Grade A tertiary hospital, one needs to spend an extra one million yuan. There are a lot of people paying an extra 1.5 million yuan.

Wang said that he could arrange a patient to have a kidney transplant at a Grade A tertiary hospital, but that would cost an extra one million yuan. The family member was astonished by the expensiveness. He said, “Lots of people have lots of money. Plenty of people would pay (an extra) 1.5 million”.

4. The Grade A tertiary hospital are “connected with us”!

When the family member said that they would like to go to a Grade A tertiary hospital to have the kidney transplant, Wang said, “They are connected with us, do you know that? They have done 300 cases now. If you go there later, they will have done 301 cases.”

#### Phone Investigation Recording

Wang: Who is that?

Investigator: Hi, Mr. Wang?

Wang: Yes, hello! how are you!

Investigator: I have called you so many times. Why didn’t you pick up? Hello!

Wang: I can't pick up my phone sometimes, and I can't call you back. You don't take the phone you called me with, you didn't call me from your cellphone, I have no way to call you back.

Investigator: I see.

Wang: I could not call you back.

Investigator: Yes, later I called you on Monday, and you didn't answer me.

Wang: That's true, you know that I was in a surgery most of the times, you know.

Busy in a surgery, I cannot bring the phone to the surgery room, you know. I guess I was busy when you called me.

Investigator: Are you also able to do surgeries?

Wang: I can't do surgeries. We have to go to the hospital, sometimes.

Investigator: Yes, then, that day I want to call you to ask you something, such as, you are asking some people to perform a surgery. How are their surgical skills? Can you invite those doctors, who are director-level, oh, like that....

Wang: I can only say this to you, the thing is, let's just say, they have done more cases this year than the Grade A tertiary hospitals, any Grade A tertiary hospital.

Investigator: No, then are you...a director-level doctor? Like our Chao-Yang (Hospital)'s...

Wang: Of course, that's director level.

Investigator: Ah?

Wang: They must be directors.

Investigator: Directors then.

Wang: They must be directors.

Investigator: Oh, you mean the doctors from Chao-Yang Hospital and the Armed Police Hospital are all at the director level. The directors would come over to do the surgeries in person, right?

Wang: Yes. Do you, do you want to do it in a Grade A tertiary hospital or a small hospital?

Investigator: Didn't you, didn't you say that there's one, who can do it very fast, in your own operating room...

Wang: The fast one, let me tell you, is definitely at the director level, but you won't see the director, who does surgeries very fast, you know, only the patients can see him.

Investigator: Why? How come I won't see him doing surgeries?

Wang: Because you won't be allowed to see him. They won't allow you to go to the hospital.

Investigator: Not allowed...didn't you say that...

Wang: They only let the patient go to the hospital.

Investigator: Don't you do the operations in your own operating room? Isn't that faster, to do it?

Wang: Right, but they won't let you go there, you understand?

Investigator: Oh.

Wang: They only let the patients go there.

Investigator: Ah, during the time they do...

Wang: You can go after surgery.

Investigator: Oh, you don't let the (patients') family members stay there during the surgeries, right?

Wang: Right, right, right.

Investigator: Oh, so it is this way. Ah, then I, then I... then I, then I know. After I called you that time, did you do a lot already?

Wang: Yeah, every day. I finished another surgery yesterday, you know.

Investigator: Hum, every day, that's really...

Wang: The Chinese New Year is approaching again, you know?

Investigator: Let's say, I mean, if you say that, let's say that we have the donor check-up. You said during tissue typing, would the donor go there with the patient?

Wang: Yes, they go together. They are together during the entire process.

Investigator: If they go there together, then are you saying, that this donor happens to be matching with my patient? Can they match?

Wang: It is like this. By now we would have already had the information of his tissue typing on hand. You know? We already have his tissue typing results.

Investigator: Oh, oh.

Wang: When you arrive and give me your (patient's) tissue typing results, I would find a matching donor for you. I will give you a matching donor, you know. I will see who can match with your patient.

Investigator: Oh, oh, I see that, these two people, who do the surgeries, must not do it in a hospital, in a Grade A tertiary hospital. They can only do it in your operating room, right?

Wang: If you want to go to a Grade A tertiary hospital, you can. I can also arrange it.

Investigator: Do I need to pay more money?

Wang: The Grade A tertiary hospitals are expensive, huh, huh.

Investigator: Do I need to pay more?

Wang: Grade A tertiary hospitals would require some more.

Investigator: Ah? Extra? 100 yuan?

Wang: Not 100 yuan, a million yuan, for the Grade A tertiary hospitals

Investigator: Oh? Then it is one million yuan extra for us to go to a Grade A tertiary hospital. Then, who would go there? You scare me to death.

Wang: Plenty of them do! There are plenty of rich people. He he he...

Investigator: Really, that's one million, then...

Wang: Lots of people have lots of money. Plenty of people would pay (an extra) 1.5 million, 1.5 million, do you know that?

Investigator: Oh, let me tell you one other thing, Mr. Wang, I have another issue that I would like to ask you about. My elder sister has already registered in a hospital. She is now in the queue, but she is still waiting, waiting for the transplantation. I'm...

Wang: I'm sure that she won't make it in the queue, do you know why?

Investigator: Ah?

Wang: She definitely won't make it wait in queue.

Investigator: Right, that's it. He said that the queue...

Wang: And, let me tell you, I will tell you this, even if you can get to your turn, there is no good stuff, you know? Inside the hospitals, you can't get the good stuff by queueing up, so let's just say that, do you understand?

Investigator: What good stuff do you mean?

Wang: We have been doing this for so many years, and we are too familiar with these things inside it.

Investigator: What do you mean about the good stuff? Do you mean the donors?

Wang: You can't get a good kidney source by being in the queue.

Investigator: Oh.

Wang: You should know, you are, you will definitely not be able to get a good kidney source waiting for your turn, you know that?

Investigator: Hey, you said those kidney sources, how can they not be good? Didn't you say that they are all under 25 years old?

Wang: I mean, when you queue up in the hospital, (you don't get the good-quality ones).

Investigator: Oh, in the hospital, I see. But they also did a lot of surgeries. Like that Armed Police Hospital and that Chao-Yang Hospital. Don't they do several hundred cases a year? Aren't those pretty good, right?

Wang: These things, I, I think it's useless to tell you about these things, do you know that? Meaningless! What they do, what they do, do you know? They are connected with us, do you know that? If you want to do it there, well, they have done 300 cases now, they have done 300 cases. If you go there later, they will have done 301 cases. Do you understand, or are you still unclear how it works? He he he. You, as a patient, you instruct the donor to do a medical check-up. After that, you would have seen everything, won't you say this is a good thing?

Investigator: Oh, what do you mean by 301 cases? Have they already done 300 cases in their hospital?

Wang: Hahaha~

Investigator: Hehe, I...

Wang: I said that if you go there, there will be the 301st case. Do you understand me?

Investigator: I also have a friend, who wants to be an intermediary for you. This friend. He is from Gansu. There are several hospitals over there, without donors.

Later, I told him about your situation, and he said that it was very good. He happened to, yesterday, or the day before yesterday, he called the Zhejiang, Zhejiang Red Cross and they could sell him some donors, that is liver and kidney donors. Then I told him. I said, "Then you should contact this person, whom I spoke about with you". I didn't tell him your last name. I said that there is a person, who contacted me and who said that they have a lot of kidney sources. I told him, "You can ask him, if he can transfer you some of this type of donors?" He has no kidney source there, so he cannot do

(surgeries). In the past two years, because the local people, they are not so open minded, and there is no such thing as organ donation there. Can you, can you be a provider (of organ donors) to him, to have him contact you?

Wang: I can definitely supply (donors) to him. But I can't deal with someone I don't know. I can't cooperate with him, you know. I don't even know what you do. What if you are a reporter, a policewoman, right?

Investigator: Me, a reporter? A reporter talking to you in this way? I am an old lady. How could I be a reporter? You...

Wang: He he he...

Investigator: I am in my 70s, I can still...

Wang: Because we are doing this, basically, we generally deal only with people we know or are very familiar, or we know that you are a hospital's doctor or a director. The rest of people, whom we don't know. We don't want to get in touch with them, do you understand?

Investigator: Right, my friend, he is from Gansu. He is a doctor of a hospital in Gansu. He said that they have no kidney sources at all. So he wants to come to the inland to look for kidney sources, look for donors, liver sources or something.

Wang: Sure, as long as he's only a doctor in a hospital, that is fine, that would be great! I, I am very willing to work with him. Ha ha ha ha~

Investigator: That is, I will ask you about the basic arrangement first. That is, if he wants it, you can distribute (organs) to him. How about the transportation?

Wang: Definitely not... let's put it this way, if he wants to do it, it has to be at his place, somewhere near his hospital, you understand?

Investigator: Right, right.

Wang: Near his hospital... It depends on his (surgery) volume. If, if it is a large volume, then we have to go build an operating room near his hospital.

Investigator: Oh, to build an operating room here...

Wang: Directly, directly near their hospital...

Investigator: What about the donors?

Wang: The donors will be taken there, and the organs can be excised there.

Investigator: Oh, oh, this way, Oh, it's like this. He also said that if you, because he called Zhejiang yesterday, they might have talked about the prices, that is, to find a kidney, say a kidney or a liver, the Red Cross over there can offer (organs) to him. Don't you think that it's very interesting? Yes, yes, yes, have you heard of it? He said that the Red Cross can help supply (organs to) him.

Wang: Now everything goes through the Red Cross. I know about this, everything goes through the Red Cross.

Investigator: I thought it's through the hospitals? Wouldn't the hospitals know that the Red Cross takes the donors away from the middle? And they just gave them to somewhere else?

Wang: There are a lot of interests involved in this, you know? This is something between them.

Investigator: Right, right, yesterday, yesterday he directly called a man at the Zhejiang Red Cross. He told him that he could provide (organs) for them. Now I want to ask you, if I want to tell him, like the cost of the kidney sources and liver sources, can you give a general price, if you give him livers and kidneys (in the future).

Wang: Oh, 200,000 yuan each.

Investigator: Each kidney? How about livers?

Wang: Yes, each kidney, no liver.

Investigator: No liver, only kidneys. 200,000 yuan each.

Wang: Yes.

Investigator: Then I, that's what he heard yesterday, from the man at the Zhejiang Red Cross. The price was about the same. That's what he told me. It seems that the national market is pretty much the same?

Wang: Yes, they're almost the same (everywhere), right.

Investigator: They're almost the same...

Wang: You know, how do I put it? It depends on the quantity. If it is a small volume, it's hard for us to work with him, you know? Gansu is so far away from here. It's not worth it for me to go there for a small volume, do you understand?

Investigator: Yes, I, I will talk to him again. They were all using the organs from executed prisoners (in transplants) before. But afterwards, there are no more death-row prisoners, so they can't do it anymore. Since you are capable...

Wang: Which hospital are they?

Investigator: My friend is in Lanzhou. There are several (organ transplant) hospitals in Lanzhou now, such as the First Hospital of Lanzhou University and the Second Hospital. Because my friend should be in the First or Second Hospital of Lanzhou University, I will ask him again. Anyway, he is in an affiliated hospital of Lanzhou University. I ran into him the other day and started talking about this. He told me about the call to the Zhejiang Red Cross for livers, kidneys, kidney sources. I thought it was such a coincidence. So I call you today again to ask about it. First, I'd like to ask about my situation, and then his situation. If you think it is possible, I will then let him contact you, okay? If not, it's not a big deal for me personally.

Wang: Ok, sure.

Investigator: I don't want to...

Wang: Sure, you can, when the time comes, you can, we can work altogether, you know?

Investigator: Yes, ok, how about...

Wang: You don't have to worry about anything. You will just get a cut from each surgery. You understand?

Investigator: How much can I get? I am just passing the word, not that I can do anything specific.

Wang: At a minimum, if it is a successful arrangement, at least you will get 10,000 yuan per operation.

Investigator: Wow, 10,000 yuan, hey, that's quite a bit. Then I, I better get this done, then you are helping me with a sideline business. I am retired now, certainly I can take it as a sideline business, ha ha.

Wang: Right, you don't have to do anything, you don't have to worry about anything. Each operation he does, you will get 10,000 yuan., it is pretty good for you to get 10,000 yuan each time, isn't it? If he is in the hospital of Lanzhou University, like you said, he can do at least 100 cases a year, no problem.

Investigator: No problem.

Wang: Do you understand?

Investigator: Yeah? I can get 1 million yuan from 100 operations?

Wang: One million yuan, that definitely is no problem!

Investigator: Wow! This is too, too tempting! Then I must, then I'd better hurry up. After the call with you today, I will call him right away to tell him about it, to see if he can get (organs) from you. It is more convenient, more convenient than getting them from the Zhejiang Red Cross, the Zhejiang Red Cross...

Wang: Just a second, it is like this, it is like this. You listen to me. The Red Cross is legal. We are not legal. If he gets them from us, he has to bear more risks than if he gets them from the Red Cross. You understand?

Investigator: Oh, being legal, can (the Red Cross) also sell these kidney sources? He can himself...

Wang: Yes, he can, he can sell them, but it is not legal to sell them, you know? But if he sells under the name of the Red Cross, distributes them under the name of the Red Cross, then he will have no problem, you understand?

Investigator: Oh, oh, it is like this.

Wang: That is the backdoor transaction between them. Do you understand? This thing is the same as when the officials make corruption deals.

Investigator: Oh, oh, hum, that is... but then again, your kidney sources definitely are better?

Wang: That is for sure, 100%.

Investigator: You said that the donors are under the age of 25. You don't accept people over 25 years old even if they are willing to sell?

Wang: Oh, yes, basically all of them are under the age of 25, and donors of 27 or 28 years old may be accepted if their conditions are particularly good. You know.

Investigator: That is...

Wang: But definitely not over the age of 28, 100%, you know? Not over the age of 28.

Investigator: Oh, that is great, that... that's fine, I... I will, after this, I will, I should talk to my friend. Look, then this, this friend, I see, he, I'll let him contact you directly, I will ask him again, ok?

Wang: Yes, sure, yes.

Investigator: Alright, OK, OK, then.

Wang: Yes, then, I, anyway, my phone is like this. If you really can't get in touch with me, because sometimes I can't pick it up, I can't get back to you, do you understand?

I can't get back to you, you have to call me repeatedly, or you can give me a (phone) number. You can use a mobile phone number, which isn't linked to your ID card, you understand?

Investigator: Ok.

Wang: There is, there is a kind of mobile phone numbers, which do not need an ID card (to apply one). You should get one.

Investigator: Oh.

Wang: It is easy to contact each other this way, ok.

Investigator: Ah, ok, ok, ok, ok, I ...I will contact you later.

Wang: Ok, ok.

Investigator: Ok, ok, bye, bye!

Wang: All right, great!
